

Confirmation Registration and Info

Confirmation at Light of Christ traditionally takes place during grades 7-9 (with Affirmation of Baptism celebration taking place the spring of 10th grade). Confirmation is an opportunity for youth to learn, make new friends and grow in faith as they journey to "affirm" the promises made in their baptism. Families are asked to register each year so that we have the most current info for each child/family. 10th



grade students do NOT need to register but will receive updates via email.

This fall we will meet entirely outdoors on Wednesdays from 6:30-7:45 pm (with HS Fellowship taking place from 7:30-9:00 pm) through MEA. After MEA we will assess things to make a decision for winter plans. If there is heavy rain, we will just cancel (not meet online or plan to reschedule). Please visit our <u>website</u> for our registration link and fall schedule plans.

Here are a few other details:

- We ask that each youth/family have a Gmail address so that they can join and access their small group's Google Classroom.
- Confirmation Orientation will take place on Wednesday, September 8th from 6:30-7:30 pm at church (for all youth and at least one parent) followed by our Guide Training (7:30-8:30).
- Our first day of Confirmation is Wednesday, September 15th.
- Please register as soon as you are able so that we can plan!
- We ask that 7th graders register <u>no later than Wednesday, September 1st</u> so that we can plan small groups.

HS Fellowship this Fall

Youth in grades 9-12 are invited to participate in HS Fellowship each Wednesday night from 7:30-9:00 pm outside at church beginning September 15th. This year we will begin our evenings by helping to lead large group games for Confirmation. Then we'll have a bonfire, snacks, other games and fellowship time.
