Outdoor Worship Together!

We have good news! On July 19th we will hold an outdoor worship service! There are a few details we would like to share with the congregation ahead of time. In order to maintain a healthy environment the worship service will look a little different than our normal services:

- Masks will not be required outdoors, but we ask that each family remain at least six feet apart on the lawn.
- We ask congregation members to refrain from singing along with the songs as this is a high-risk activity in group settings.
- We will not participate in group prayer, since speaking together in a large group also raises the risk level.
- We will hold communion at the outdoor service. Each congregation member will receive a prepackaged wafer and prepackaged wine.
- We will pre-record a service that will be posted on our YouTube page as usual for those who cannot make it. There will be no Zoom communion, but we will include communion liturgy in the recorded service.
- Please bring your own chairs.
- If you are experiencing Covid-like symptoms or have been exposed to a person diagnosed with Covid, we ask that you remain at home.
- We will send out a Sign Up Genius soon! We highly encourage all of you to sign up for the service ahead of time as it is helpful for us to know how many people will be attending so we can plan out spacing, volunteers, etc. Keep in mind that the limit on outdoor gatherings is 250 people.

We are so excited to give everyone the chance to worship together in person! We thank you ahead of time for your flexibility and willingness to follow all the instructions above. Our top priority is making sure our members stay happy and healthy!

Stewardship of the Gap the In-between Time During the Pandemic

Does all of this sometimes feel like we're all holding our breath, waiting for things to pass...to "get back to normal?" Or at least to get to a "new normal." Do you find yourself thinking, "Once this thing passes, then I'll _____?" Things sometimes seem so disrupted, so turned upside down, so tenuous. In fact, many feel more anxious, worried, on edge, if you will. There's a gap between what is and what we hope for or anticipate. So, what do we do? How are we to manage (steward) this sort of in-between time? Where's God and our faith in all of this? What are we to do?

Perhaps just a small step back will give us perspective. Isn't it true that we're most always in some state of being in-between...some feeling of incompleteness or yearning or striving or waiting? Indeed. This side of heaven we experience what feels to be a chasm between what is and what should be. Perhaps that just feels more significant right now. So be it. Are we to remain stuck...sidelined... powerless?

Scripture speaks to times like these in a variety of ways. God's Word gives us direction, inspiration about how we are to "steward" or be managers of these seasons of life that sometimes feel like they are draining us of energy and focus.

Our calling is to have and act with faith. Check these out:

- * "Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see." Hebrews 11:1
- "Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth." 1. Jn. 3:18
- "[You] are to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous and ready to share, thus storing up treasure for [yourselves] as a good foundation for the future, so that [you] may take hold of that which is truly life." 1 Tim. 6:18-19

The bottom line is that we are to be stewards of this in-between time by having and acting in faith.

Pray about this. Ask, what is it, Lord, that you would have me do? What gesture of love? What act of service? And then do whatever the Lord prompts you to do. Write someone a note. Volunteer. Give a gift. Put in a phone call. Stand up for or against something important. Engage. Be about the right, Godly thing.

Be a faithful steward of the in-between. Stand in the gap. It matters!

1st Communion and Confirmation Celebrations Rescheduled

Light of Christ staff and Council have been talking about the celebrations that we missed this spring since we could not worship together in person. First Communion and Confirmation Sunday both got postponed due to Coronavirus. Here are details about our plans for these faith milestones to take place later this summer: each celebration will have a recorded worship service that families will watch at home.
