He came, and his Light would not go out.*

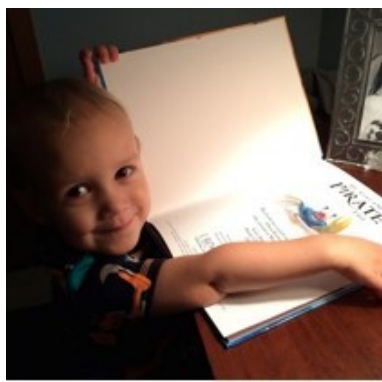
*He came to a world which did not mesh,
