Word for the Week

C. S. Lewis once said: "Jov is the serious business of heaven." He was convinced that a grim, sour-faced, joyless spirituality was light years away from what God intended. Instead, God seeks to fill our lives and our world with genuine joy – a joy that is not dictated by the circumstances in which we find ourselves.

Martin Luther found the same thing to be true. Before he discovered God's grace for himself, his spirituality was a grim business. He tried, and failed, to make himself perfect before God. As a result, he came to hate God because he believed that God was demanding something—perfection—that Luther could never attain.

But once Luther discovered that God is a God of grace— and that God gives the very thing that God demands, Luther's spirituality, like his entire life, got turned upside down.

Luther began to advocate for a joyful spirituality. Luther believed that we should rejoice in all of God's gifts to us. Consequently, Luther thoroughly enjoyed life. He enjoyed wife, Katie, and their children. He enjoyed good food and a good beer (he was German after all!). He enjoyed his work as a professor of the Old Testament. He enjoyed his colleagues and his friends. He enjoyed making, and even composing, music. So take to heart the opening stanza of one of Luther's most famous hymns:

> Dear Christians, one and all, rejoice, with exultation springing, and, with united heart and voice and holy rapture singing, proclaim the wonders God has done, proclaim the victory God has won, how precious was our ransom.

Your Healing and Wholeness

Committee is *excited* to invite you all to a special event on **Saturday, November 13**th **at 10:00 am**. We will be hosting a NAMI Minnesota program called "In Our Own Voice" to help bring awareness to mental illness, break the stigma associated with having mental illness, and share the good news that once correctly diagnosed, a person with a mental disorder can manage his or her symptoms with therapy, medication and support.

NAMI Minnesota has asked two volunteers to speak about their journeys living with mental illness and achieving recovery. The presentation incudes personal stories and video clips as well as an opportunity to ask questions.

This 90-minute program is open to the public and we encourage you to invite your families, friends, neighbors, and coworkers. Flyers have been posted in Delano and surrounding area churches and places of business.

You can attend in-person in the sanctuary wearing masks. (Speakers will not wear masks during their presentation so everyone can hear their message.) As an alternative, the event will be livestreamed on our Light of Christ Facebook page. Simply "LIKE" Light of Christ Lutheran Church of Delano, MN and you can view it live at 10am on November 13th. 
The B-I-B-L-E, Yes, That's the Book for Me!
