

Columbarium Update

Work on the Columbarium and Memorial Garden is underway! Soil prep is complete, footings have been poured and the foundations have been installed. We are anticipating delivery and installation of the columbarium units early in the week of August 15th, and masonry work will follow shortly after that. We anticipate landscaping in September. We are looking forward to an installation service of the Columbarium and Memorial Garden yet this fall.

The landscape and memorial garden area surrounding the columbarium will include beautiful trees, shrubs and perennial flowers. Additionally, there will be benches and a bubbling boulder water feature. There will be opportunities to purchase an item in the memorial garden to honor/memorialize your loved one. This will include a small plaque/marker where you can include their name. Columbarium Committee members will be available after services beginning August 21 to display the plans and answer your questions. You will also be able to purchase your memorial at that time.
