Tentative Schedule for the week:

Sunday, June 8th

- 8:30 am Arrive at LOC to load vehicles (please pack light and wear your trip shirt!!)
- 9:30 am Attend worship at LOC (trip blessing during the service)
- 11:00 am Depart for St. Paul (bring a sack lunch that we can eat on the drive)
- 1:00 pm Arrive and get settled at Luther Memorial Church in South St. Paul, MN
- Orientation for the week and grocery shopping!
- Afternoon/Evening Explore local attractions, free time/games at the park across the street from the church, meal/clean up/worship teams all meet and work
- Evening: Supper, worship (bonfire?), free-time, bedtime

Monday-Wednesday, June 9th – 11th

- 8 am Wake up, breakfast, morning devos, pack lunches and get ready to leave
- 8 am Volunteer at local social-service organization
- Around 3-4 pm Return to the church
- Evening: showers at Central Square Community Center, down time, dinner, activity, worship

Thursday, June 12th

- Breakfast, devos, pack lunches and all belongings; leave for a "fun" day out and picnic lunch
- 5 pm? Arrive back at LOC, hug your parents and thank God for an excellent trip!
