Caring Corner

(from Sue Fink of the Healing & Wholeness Committee)



As I began thinking about where God is leading our Healing and Wholeness Ministry this coming church year, I looked back on all we've done the past 2 ½ years. Our focus up until now has been on bringing awareness to mental illness, encouraging conversations about our commonality in living with mental illness in ourselves and those we care about, educating us on various mental illnesses, and finding ways to help ourselves and one another to achieve mental health.

God put on my heart this week to consider what healing and wholeness actually mean, as a compass to lead us to a clearer focus on what it can mean for our Light of Christ family as we continue developing our Healing and Wholeness Ministry.

My online research found several examples of definitions:

Wholeness, according to Webster's dictionary, is "the state of forming a complete and harmonious whole; unity". Also, "the state of being unbroken or undamaged" which can refer to things, ideas and people. Spiritually, wholeness is the state of being perfectly well in body, soul (mind, will and emotions) and spirit, which was God's original design for us before "the fall." In eternity we will return to pure wholeness because of Jesus.

Healing means to "make whole or sound or free from illness or disease." Interestingly the word "heal" comes from the ancient word, *haelan*, which is also the root of the word "holy" which means "spiritually pure." Centuries ago, humans associated healing with perceptions of wholeness and spirituality.

Healing is related to wholeness and wholeness is experienced in connection with others. We're meant to seek help and offer help to one another. And healing can occur in ways other than curing. As a hospice nurse I learned that healing and wholeness for a person can happen through very serious illnesses and even as a person is dying.

Our Light of Christ family is becoming more transparent in sharing our troubles which in turn brings us closer and more connected. Let us also share our faith and prayers with one another because it is through our common shared faith and grace that we become more whole together and as individual and unique children of God.

God seeks you continually. May you listen and seek Him and surrender every nook and cranny of your life as you grow toward healing and wholeness.

of flesh and blood or knitting of bone to bone.

True healing is wholeness, where body, soul and spirit unite.

True healing is peace, the knowledge of God's presence, a hope that knows no end.

True healing cries 'Father, not my will but yours.'

Adult Choir Begins!


Choir rehearsals will resume on Tuesday, September 13th, 6:30-7:30. Rehearsals occur weekly.
