
Outdoor Service Brings Congregation Back Together!



First Communion and Confirmation Sunday both got postponed due to Coronavirus. Here are details about our plans for these faith milestones to take place later this summer:

- † There will be two dates when kids/families can sign up for a 10-minute time slot to come to the Sanctuary at Light of Christ, receive the blessing/First Communion and take photos.
