

We encourage all to learn more and be able to support anyone struggling with their emotions and thoughts, and we feel strongly that youth and caregivers need to be equipped to recognize, come alongside, and help in these situations.

LOC Monthly Income - Actual versus Budget


Year To Date Summary – August 2024

Welcome to a new year! This year we have 63 youth in our Confirmation ministry (grades 7-9) along with 21 adult Guides/ Subs and many HS Junior Guides! We also have a great group of 10th graders that are going through their Mentoring sessions before being confirmed next spring. *Thank you for keeping these ministries, volunteers, youth, and their families in your daily prayers throughout the year!* If you are reading this and want to support the youth and families involved in this ministry, we ALWAYS welcome donations to our scholarship fund...this mainly helps with more expensive things like retreats, camps, and trips. **THANK YOU** for your partnership in ministry (and support of our youth)!

New to Confirmation this year!

- New Schedule: Confirmation will now start on Wednesdays at 6:15 PM (and still go until 8:00 PM). We will just begin our games 15 minutes earlier in order to allow more time for small groups. This also means that SLICE will be earlier (from 5:45-6:15 PM each night that we meet). This change came from feedback from our Guides and we're excited to see how it positively impacts our relationships and Confirmation ministry!
- 7th and 8th grade Mission Trip! In Summer 2025 we will have our first mission trip for completed grades 7 and 8. This trip will take place in the Twin Cities from a Sunday-Thursday (dates TBD). Watch for more details coming soon and plan to attend our Info Meeting on Wednesday, October 30th (8-9 PM)! This is also the day that registration will open.
- **HS Jr. Guides:** This year our HS Jr. Guides will have a little different schedule... they will begin in the Living Room at 6:45 each week with Heidi Wuerger (and one additional adult) to have fellowship time and talk about the night. Then, the HS youth will join Confirmation groups during small group time from 7:20-8:00 PM. We invite all HS youth to join us!

We are SO excited to have a fall Confirmation retreat again this year (after not being able to find dates that worked last year). All youth (grades 7-10) are expected to attend (and truly won't want to miss out!). Here are the details:

Where? Lake Wapogasset Lutheran Bible Camp in Amery, WI

Who? Grades 7-10 and adult volunteers from LOC

What? An incredible faith and relationship-building weekend filled with campfires, games, important conversations, time with friends and lots of good food ©

<u>Why</u>? We know that these longer times together provide a unique opportunity to grow deeper together in our friendships and relationship with God. We love our Wednesday nights, and yet these retreats are often "where the magic" happens – that so many youth talk about in their Faith Statements when they are confirmed! For that reason, we say that these retreats are "required" for all Confirmation youth, because we know how important and significant they are! Please put it on your calendar and make it a priority... you'll be glad you did.

<u>Cost</u>? \$225/youth – this covers the retreat fee (\$185), transportation, supplies, snacks and adult costs (our adults attend free). If this fee is prohibitive, *PLEASE* reach out to Kirsten. We want all youth to attend, no matter what. Partial or full scholarships are available!!!

On Wednesday, October 2nd we will be having a special event to raise awareness for Mental Health. We encourage all Confirmation youth and their families to participate before Confirmation that night! Here's the schedule for that day:
