In April the Light of Christ OWLs hosted a lunch and learn sharing information on "End of Life Planning." Light of Christ is blessed to have been able to highlight our own Columbarium and Memorial Garden as a wonderful option in end-of-life planning. Offering a



Columbarium on the grounds of Light of Christ fulfills the church's mission to oversee the spiritual life of its congregation from baptism through life to death. Beautiful landscaping provides a peaceful space for prayer, remembrance and meditation.

The Light of Christ structure houses 96 niches with each niche built to accommodate two urns. Current and past members of Light of Christ and members of their immediate families are eligible to choose the Columbarium as their final resting place.

We invite you to take a moment to visit our Columbarium and Memorial **Garden** and experience first-hand the tranquility and beauty it has to offer. Then consider the gift you give to your family and loved ones by making end -of-life plans prior to death. A gracious gift providing peace of mind and a forever beautiful place of remembrance.

Blessed Monday to you!

There is an old song that goes, "don't build your house on a sandy land, don't build it too near the shore..." it goes on to talk about how if your faith isn't resting on Jesus, life will blow you around. However, if you rest your faith in Jesus, you will have solid foundations. It is based on Matthew 7 and through the storms last week it kept running through my head. The best news is that our faith **is** built on the solid rock of Jesus.



The good news is that so is our church (metaphorically and physically). The bad news is that our parking lot is not. The ground that the south part of our parking lot is built on a bad foundation and the quote we got last year did not take that into account. You may have noticed as you drove in that the south side of the parking lot has broken up far more than the north half. When the company looked at this, they thought we were lucky we did not do the work that was bid last year, because the next time we had a bad winter it would once again need major repair. Instead, they believe we need to put a better foundation under the south side of the parking lot.

Here is what we know right now:

- 1) The company advised us not to do the work that we accepted last year at the special meeting in July, because if we execute the former bid, they do not believe it will last without fixing the foundation.
- 2) They have issued us new bids with the foundational work included, which not surprisingly, are higher.
- 3) The council, because of the increase, has asked for at least another bid to be sought on this work.
- 4) After the new bids have come in, we will need to have a congregational meeting to use more of the funds that are being collected for the capital appeal to fund the parking lot (as long as the congregation is willing to allocate those further funds to this project).
- 5) We are looking for ways to act on the worst spots of the parking lot right now while this process moves forward.

If you have questions or concerns, you can come and talk to me or your council representatives. Know that we know how much the parking lot needs fixing but also do not want to waste the resources that God (and you!) have provided by patching a parking lot instead of fixing it the right way.




