	Financial Report: Luke gave an update on the financial report. Nothing concerning at this time. We are \$7500 below budget. We need \$74,762 for Capital campaign for parking lot. Congregational update in April giving us 3 months of financial situation. Brandt motioned to approve, Ryan seconded. Approved by all.
	<p>Old Business</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 10% tithe on Capital Campaign- Pastor to research. Was voted on by congregation but is not required. Our mission is to tithe. Luke asked when we discussed how to allocate the tithe on this Capital Campaign. Discussion will be on May agenda. • Date/location for Council 2026 Goals Retreat: April 26th 3-6pm. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Pastor looking into location and will let us know. Location Methodist church. Lisa will send out chat for food to bring. • Parking lot update (Brandt) Possibly May depending on weather. No changes right now in cost. • Parking during construction (with Head start) Staff can park on County Line Rd. Confirmation can be held off site. Should we have them start when Head Start is done for the season? Pastor will check on dates. Head Start bus may be able to drop kids off on County Line Rd and have someone escort them to church.

Wright County gave a presentation after church last week. They will have more follow-up meetings.

Erin CFM report, discussion to raise tuition on Weds from \$100/yr to \$150 unless parent agrees to volunteer for two sessions, then tuition would be \$100. Luke: No report from Technology Committee. Ryan: No update on Healing and Wholeness. Pat: Misson/Evangelism welcoming suggestions on gratitude cards. Lisa said we have some council rep signups needed.</p>
