### Confession of Faith: Guidelines

This confession of faith is an opportunity for you to express your core faith convictions. As such, it should be uniquely yours, much like your fingerprints. It should be around three minutes long, and it can be done in almost any medium - a written confession, an original song, a film piece, or a painting or sculpture that you would interpret in three minutes. But before you get started, share your ideas with me when you have your interview. You'll present your confession of faith during Lent 2019. As a way to get you started, here are some ideas.

#### Belonging to Christ

As a baptized child of God, you belong to Christ and to everyone else who belongs to Christ. You are part of God's family. When are the moments in your life when you have sensed your belonging to God's family – at home, here at Light of Christ, at Bible Camp, at youth gatherings, with other Christian friends? When has the experience of belonging to Christ been most powerful?

#### Believing in Christ

As a baptized child of God, you believe in Christ. Believing is more than just having information about Christ, or agreeing with certain biblical and theological ideas. Believing is trusting Christ in every situation for every need - especially in the most difficult times of your life. It is putting your life in Christ's hands. When have you trusted Christ? When have you discovered that he is trustworthy, and that he keeps all his promises to us?

#### Becoming like Christ

As a baptized child of God, you are being transformed by the Holy Spirit to become more and more like Christ. It's a transformation that began at your baptism and will not be finished until you reach eternal glory. You are "under construction." In what ways are you becoming more Christ-like? In what ways is Christ putting to death your self-centeredness, and making you more Christcentered and other-centered?
