(from Sue Fink of the Healing & Wholeness Committee)

An announcement this month from the Minnesota Dept. of Health:

In observation of *September as Suicide Prevention Awareness Month*, health officials are reminding Minnesotans that suicide is preventable, recovery is possible, and help is available at any time by calling <u>988</u>.

Earlier this summer, the U.S. rolled out a nationwide three-digit dialing code – 988 – as a way to access suicide prevention and crisis support. Since switching to 988 on July 16, calls to Minnesota's four call centers have increased 44%. Minnesota has also seen a 173% increase in web chats (since January 2022) and 250% increase in texts to 988. The increase is believed to be in large part because the new 988 dialing option made it easier to remember how to access a trained counselor for suicide support and resources. Minnesota received 33,887 calls, 4,099 chats, and 1,306 texts in 2021.

The 988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline and Minnesota's four call centers offer support 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

There continues to be a great need for 988 support services as suicide, or death by intentional self-harm, has been steadily rising in Minnesota for the past 20 years. According to preliminary data, there were 777 suicides in 2021, mirroring trends across the United States. This is the seventh straight year in which more than 700 Minnesotans died by suicide. In addition, each year in Minnesota there are more than 10,000 self-harm or suicidal injuries treated by health care providers.

"We know the last few years have been incredibly challenging mentally, emotionally and physically for many Minnesotans," said Minnesota Commissioner of Health Jan Malcom. "Please take advantage of this awareness month to check in with the people in your life and consider reminding them that the 988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline is available for anyone in need of crisis or mental health support."

Let's have open discussions, brave conversations and lots of prayer to do our part as a Caring Congregation in supporting our members and families in preventing suicide.

Funeral Ministry Serving the Bereaved

Helping people in their time of need is central to what we do as a church. And, most certainly, when there is a death, this is one of those important times. There is pastoral care extended, members reach out to offer condolences and love, a celebration of life service is planned, and often there is a reception that follows so that the family can spend some extra time with their guests.

All of this takes a group of dedicated members to help each time there is a funeral/reception. Generally, specific arrangements have been previously made, and most food items (if there is a lunch) are delivered to the church beforehand. So, Funeral Ministry Team Members show up early, help to set the tables, get food and beverages arranged, provide hospitality (even some direction-giving if needed), and then serve the food/desserts/beverages when guests arrive.

Generally, family will have decided upon either a light meal (most of that food delivered by Coborn's) or desserts and beverage. In both of those cases we invite Light of Christ members to make and deliver to the church a variety of desserts.

Dishes are cleared and run through the dishwasher, dried and put away. Tables are wiped clean. Other items put back in place.

The number of Funeral Ministry Team members varies depending upon the size of the funeral, but generally between 6 and 10 people are needed.

Our hope is to include new folks in this ministry and these tasks. So, please pray about serving at some point. Ginny Iverson has been the long-time coordinator of this ministry. And she would like to train in someone new to take the reins.
