This year our Fifth Sunday contributions in June will go to Kids Hope, a national ministry organization that has been working for 30 years to connect needy students in a local school district with 1-1 mentor volunteers from a local church. Our LOC Kids Hope volunteer mentors and three others from local Delano churches meet with their student for one hour each week for the entire school year. Our mentors have been working with Delano Elementary to help students who are in need of relationship building and developing confidence and trust. These mentors are making a wonderful difference in these kids' lives. The feedback from Delano teachers and the students has been so positive and touching. Our church contributes annually to Kids Hope to support their work in 33 states engaging 17,000 students, mentors and prayer partners in 750 programs.




If you've already been receiving pre-printed envelopes each year, you will remain on the list until you request otherwise.



In the Book of Concord, (a collection of early Lutheran writings that witness to the Lutheran understanding of God's revelation in scripture) there are three creeds which are set up as ecumenical creeds. These three were all agreed to by a council of all the churches before the 9th century. The three creeds are the Apostles, the Nicene, and the Athanasian. Most of us are probably familiar with the Apostles' and Nicene creeds; we go through the Apostles for confirmation and the Nicene gets used on the highest Holy days. However, the Athanasian creed is much less familiar—although I did make us confess it yesterday! It was written in a time when Arianism (not the Aryanism of the Nazis) and the Goths and Visigoths of the north were threatening the Christian faith. Arianism said that God the Father was the true God and had created Jesus. Jesus therefore was the first thing created, but not actually God. This threatens our understand-

ing of who God is! And to clarify the Trinity, we adopted the Athanasian creed. The main purpose of this creed is to firmly set out the doctrine of the Trinity—God in three persons. This concept was described to us by the scriptures but took many years for people to understand and put into a creed. The above shield is often used to try and visually show the working of the Trinity. While all are God (and the same God), no two persons are equal to each other. Traditionally this creed is attributed to Athanasius of Alexandria, it was most likely written a century later defending the same belief that he held. While parts of it may seem archaic and others might annoy us. It is powerful to look at the documents that we hold to and talk about their importance both historically and what they tell us about our faith. So if you missed it on Sunday feel free to read this ancient creed and maybe even watch the sermon as we celebrate this week of Trinity and God's amazing ability to be bigger than our understanding in order to be big enough for all of our needs.
