## The Great Thing about Giving

My earliest recollections around giving to the church would be two-fold. One of them was as a young Sunday schooler,



either Saturday night or Sunday morning, we would each take out our Sunday school offering envelopes and put our coins into the envelope. At different times there were different orientations. At times, our parents gave us money to put into them. At other times, we were led through some conversation and deliberation around what portion of our own allowance money we would put in ourselves.

I honestly don't remember the whole Sunday school/worship schedule situation on Sunday mornings (whether they were separate or at the same time), but I do remember that when my grandparents were in town for a couple of months each year, that my grandpa would give us kids a nickel to put into the offering plate. BTW, my brother just told me that he remembered the exact same thing. But his strategy, at times, was to effectively fall asleep just before the offering time so that he could keep the nickel. "Hmmm, stealing from God," I remarked as he told me. He said, "Well, I guess it was the reality of selfishness creeping in at that early age." Indeed.

My lasting recollections or feeling about both of these early experiences of giving is that they felt good to do, that they helped me have a sense of belonging, that I somehow knew that I was a part of something bigger than myself. I'm not sure I could have articulated those feelings in such a way, but it's not too difficult for me even now to remember all of that fondly.

I still experience those simple but important realities. The great thing about giving, at least in part, is that it connects me to this day with God, with something bigger than myself. And that's pretty great!
