

The April Fifth Sunday Offering will go to the Delano Senior Center

The Friends of the Delano Senior Center is seeking donations to go directly towards the purchase of a 14-passenger lift-equipped van. The current van is a 2009 model and is showing its age.

The Senior Center offers a variety of shopping and day trips for area seniors. In 2022, the center provided van service on **more than 100 occasions**, serving **more than 200 individuals** with a total of **more than 700 rides**. They provide a mix of <u>basic</u>, <u>essential services</u> and <u>education/recreation</u> trips:

For example....

- Shopping in Monticello, Ridgedale, Eden Prairie, Hutchinson, Maple Grove, and more!
- Transportation to and from our daily lunch program
- Educational trips to museums, cultural centers, etc.
- Fun and recreation restaurants, performances, sports games, and more!
- \Rightarrow Total cost of new vehicle and lettering: **\$119,367.00**
- ⇒ City of Delano Senior Center Capital Fund Budget — \$18.600.00
- ⇒ Contribution from Gwen Kittock Memorial Fund (gift from a Delano resident who died in 2013)—
 \$35,000.00.
- ⇒ Estimated trade-in value of existing van— \$12,500.00.
- ⇒ Donations they need to solicit from senior center users and charitable organizations: \$53,267.00 They have raised \$22,000+ of the \$53,267 thus far!

2022 Statistics:

- 2022 Trips Provided: 107
- 2022 Riders (total, including duplicates): 721
- 2022 Riders (individuals): 203
- 2022 Total <u>Registered</u> Senior Center Participants: 1,142

They serve many more people above and beyond this number at public events and via phone and email referrals.

April is Counseling Awareness Month

If you (or your loved ones) are struggling with symptoms that negatively impact areas of your work, school, social, and/or family life, consider professional counseling. Counseling benefits our community; it fosters better communication skills, it promotes problem solving methods, and it provides relief from challenging mental health conditions.

If you are considering professional counseling, begin with a visit to your medical doctor, reveal your symptoms, and seek a referral.

Seek help finding the right therapist. Consult with family and friends; they might have a good recommendation. Your medical doctor might be able to recommend some quality mental health therapists for you. Insurance companies have lists of therapists, and if you have an insurance plan, your provider should be able to identify those therapists covered under your plan. Conduct an internet search for local mental health clinics. Many of these clinics have websites that provide descriptions of their therapists. Read the biographical descriptions to determine the counselor's area of expertise. Some therapists include faith-based sessions. Finding the right therapist is helpful.

Many therapists accept insurance, Health Saving Account, and/or cash payments - some therapists do not accept insurance payments. Some clinics offer a Sliding Fee Scale to help alleviate some of the financial burden.

Registration: Emailed out to all Confirmation families


















High School Fellowship
