Fifth Sunday Offering (May 30th) Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Minneapolis

Our Fifth Sunday offering in May will be going to support the Justice Fund at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Minneapolis. Since its founding in 1904, Holy Trinity has been a church deeply rooted in the diverse, immigrantrich Longfellow neighborhood, in an appreciation for learning, in traditional worship, and in a commitment to social justice.

Holy Trinity is located just east of the Minneapolis 3rd Police Precinct, and its neighborhood was where protests sprang up in the hours and days following George Floyd's death. Since that time the Church has seen an increase in the amount of people needing assistance. Pastor Ingrid Arneson Rasmussen has said they are most in need of donations to their Justice Fund to continue its work in the neighborhood. Parents of current preschoolers-4th **graders:** look at your calendar and set aside the 3rd week of July for Light of Christ's Vacation Bible School! We are excited to welcome back the children in-person. More details about each program and access to registration links are given below:
