

# **Grateful for Your Support**

Delano Helping Hands Food Shelf is so grateful for the support we receive from LOC members. December is one of the busier months for us at the Food Shelf. This year, we served over 140 households in December and gave out over 12,500 pounds of food. In total 450 people received food this month. We were able to meet this need with the support from so many at LOC. For instance:



- 60+ Confirmation students sorted donations, cleaned our coolers and freezers, and made over 200 stocking stuffers (and provided the candy for the stocking stuffers).
- 36 Voyagers put together an additional 60 stocking stuffers so we had enough for all clients who wanted them.
- 25 volunteers packed frozen food and loaded cars for our customers. December is one of the three months each year that LOC provides our Thursday afternoon volunteers.
- Many financial and food donations were provided this month including sweets, hot cocoa, blankets, and miscellaneous non-perishable food items.

If you want to know how you can help, watch the Beacon for volunteer requests. We are seeing more new clients each week and so need to add to our regular volunteers. Also, don't forget that donations can be put in the cabinet outside the Living Room. A list of items needed is included on our website.

Your financial pledge is a cornerstone to the health and vitality of our stewardship and thus to our mission and ministry. Thanks to those who have pledged!


And, if you haven't made a financial commitment or estimate of giving for 2025, we very much encourage you to do so.
