

Rooted in Faith: Healing and Wholeness in Community

This September, our theme at Light of Christ is "Rooted in Faith." Just as a tree needs deep roots to withstand storms and flourish in every season, our mental, emotional, and spiritual well-being requires deep grounding in faith, community, and belonging.

Mental health is not separate from our spiritual life. It is nurtured by it. When we are spiritually grounded, we are reminded of God's steady presence and love. This grounding provides a foundation that holds us firm when life feels overwhelming. In moments of loneliness, stress, or uncertainty, our faith reminds us that we are never truly alone.

Equally important is belonging. We were created for connection, to live in relationship with one another. Feelings of isolation can deeply affect mental health, yet God's Word points us to the healing power of community:

"So we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually we are members one of another." – Romans 12:5

Participation in community, whether in worship, small groups, service, or simple fellowship, strengthens us. When we gather, share burdens, celebrate joys, and encourage one another, we reflect the wholeness God desires for all of creation.

The Ministry of Healing and Wholeness exists to help us live into this vision. By focusing on healing and by intentionally addressing loneliness and mental illness, we seek to embody Christ's love and create spaces where everyone belongs.

This September, we invite you to reflect: Where are your roots planted? How is your faith grounding you in this season? And how might you reach out to deepen your connections with others in our community?

Let us remain rooted in faith, growing together in healing and wholeness.

New School Supplies For 50+ Students!



Baptism Informational Meeting Wednesday, September 17th, 8 PM

In the Lutheran church (ELCA) we baptize at every age because we believe God does the work and I can not be any more worthy of God's love at 6 weeks than I can at 40 years old. This has led to most people choosing to baptize their children as infants. If you have not been baptized and would like some info about baptism at LOC (especially if you are not an infant), please attend this short meeting for youth and



parent/s. If you're interested, you can also schedule an individual meeting after that with Pastor Tim to talk more specifics for your family. Youth need to be baptized before they are Confirmed (since Confirmation is an "Affirmation of Baptism").



Attention, Women! As life and schedules get busy for the fall, please consider taking time out for yourself and joining us for the women's Bible study starting in September. Participating in a Bible study is a great way to dive deeper into the word and gain new insights that strengthen our faith.

The women's Bible study will meet the first and third Mondays of the month, 6:30 – 8:00 PM at LOC, with September 15th as the first meeting. The first Monday of the month we will meet in the Living Room. On the third Monday of the month we will meet in room 106. If you need to leave early at any point that is okay. We will meet September – June. We will not meet in December. If you can't make it every time that is okay! We want you to come when you can.

We will be doing **two Bible studies by Nancy Guthrie.** The first half of our time together we will study her book *God Does His Best Work with Empty*. The second half we will study her book *Even Better than Eden*.


