We generally affirm a full slate of new and returning committee and team members at our January meeting, though we welcome new folks at any time. Please pray about where and how you can best serve.


STAYING CONNECTED

Generosity Makes Ministry Possible

We've each been blessed in order to be a blessing to others. In fact, giving and sharing is critical to the vitality of our very lives. Reminds me of an example of this.

There are two major bodies of water in the land where Jesus walked. One is the Sea of Galilee, a beautiful lake 13 miles long and 7 miles wide, filled with fish and surrounded by lush foliage.

The other body of water is the Dead Sea, 50 miles long and 11 miles wide, the shoreline of which is 1300 feet below sea level. There are no plants of any kind in or







near the water. As a matter of fact, what you'll see on the shores of the Dead Sea is white, crystals of salt covering EVERYTHING. According to extremescience.com, fish accidentally swimming into the waters from one of the several freshwater streams that feed the Sea are killed instantly, their bodies quickly coated with a preserving layer of salt crystals and then tossed onto shore by the wind and waves.

Both the Sea of Galilee and the Dead Sea are fed by the Jordan River. There is really only one difference between these two bodies of water, really only one thing that causes the Sea of Galilee to be beautiful

and alive while the Dead Sea is barren and lifeless. The Sea of Galilee has an outlet; the Dead Sea does not! Water flows through the Sea of Galilee. Water flows into the Dead Sea but not out!

I think it's the same with our lives. While the culture is obsessed with getting and having, our faith calls us into generosity – giving and sharing what we have, blessing others with our resources, being, as Jesus said, like "living streams."

While giving and pledging is a part of how we ensure that our church's ministry happens, it's also how each of us keeps healthy, faithful, and alive with blessings flowing through us as God intends.
