

Hello friends! Once again, May <u>Mental Health Awareness Month</u> is upon us. As a congregation we have come a long way toward our acceptance and understanding of mental health challenges. Please find resources for yourself or loved ones on our <u>LOC website under Support/ Mental Health</u> as well as our resource cabinet in the Narthex. Remember to <u>CALL or TEXT 988</u> if you need to talk to a trained person in case of a mental health crisis or need for support.



Our theme for May will be "*31 Days, 31 Ways 2 Pray 4 Families*" from author Catherine P. Downing, who has blogged on <u>sparksofredemptivegrace.com</u> as she navigates her son's serious mental illness challenges with bipolar disease. This has become a yearly exercise in faith for us at Light of Christ.

Please join us in daily prayer starting May 1st as posted on the <u>Light of Christ Facebook page</u>, printed as a handout at Sunday services as well as copies of the entire month of prayers in the Narthex.

If you or someone you love lives through the ups and downs of mental illness, we pray for healing and peace that comes from nurturing and being rooted in our faith and trust in our God. Keep in mind as you pray:

- First, because mental illnesses are brain disorders, pray as you would for any other physical illness.
- Because God can and does heal bodies, always pray for healing.
- Because that healing often comes through medical and therapeutic means, pray for doctors, counselors, and chemists.
- Because healing is enhanced by intentional body care, pray for good rest, nutrition, and exercise.
- Because in his providence, God doesn't always cure everyone, pray for patience, wisdom, and enduring faith.
- Prayer is an act of open-handed expectation! Never give up.

John 17:33: (Jesus) "I have told you all this so that you may have peace in me. Here on earth you will have many trials and sorrows. But take heart, because I have overcome the world." Amen!

May Food Distribution





The long Midwest winter months can be difficult for many people, leading some to make impossible choices between paying for essentials like heat or buying groceries. But with your help, more families will not have to worry about where their next meal will be coming from.

Your gift helps neighbors like Amanda, who is a mom to a teenage son. They live in a supportive housing community for mothers and their children who are emerging from homelessness and have been receiving meals through *Kitchen Coalition*, our prepared meal program. Amanda says she appreciates the food she receives all the time, but "especially when I can't afford to go to the grocery store, and it's cold, and I don't have a car."

One in four of our neighbors sought food assistance last year. But with the help of our whole community, including dedicated donors like you, we can reduce hunger today and prevent hunger tomorrow, ensuring that more of our neighbors like Amanda will have access to nutritious food when and where they need it most.

Funeral Committee/Coordinator


