Silent Prayer and Meditation in the Sanctuary

The Light of Christ Sanctuary will be available for prayer and meditation every Wednesday from 4:30-6:30 pm and every Thursday from 11:30 am-1:30 pm.

Light of Christ has not changed who we are or what we do but pandemic concerns have changed how we live out our vision as a welcoming, accepting and enjoyable place to gather.

Each of us has our own way to be close to our Lord in prayer and meditation and for many of us that closeness to God is most felt in our Light of Christ Sanctuary. This time is meant for silent prayer for each person in the Sanctuary and social distancing is to be respected. Masks and COVID-19 compliance are required. Again, this is quiet time for thought, prayer and personal connection with God.

Then they divided into several teams and played "Bed Sheet Ping Pong," which consists of teams of two trying to roll a ping pong off a blanket into their opponent's zone. There were lots of screams and laughter as they tried to be the first to get to 10 points. After the large group game, the kids divided into two smaller groups and took turns playing outside with Pastor Bruce and doing a craft in the Fellowship Hall with Ms. Catherine. For the last 20 minutes, Pastor Bruce talked to the students about worries and stress. He had them write all their worries on one side of an index card and then a prayer to Jesus about the worries on the other side. The kids learned that God gives us strength during difficult times and He invites us to pray to Him when our circumstances overwhelm us. Hopefully, the kids won't need the stress balls that they made, but they're available to them if they do - just like God is always there to relieve stress for us.
