The parking lot work has not yet been scheduled definitively but still hoping for completion this fall. May install bottom layer of class 5 gravel this fall, wait for asphalt until spring, but TBD. Building use fees Billie asked that council members review the 3 related documents prior to next month. We will approve the policy next month.

Decided Nov 16th would be better given it's the second weekend of MN deer hunting and may have better attendance. Laurie motioned that excess free will donation (after covering food costs) be used to offset the cost of the band and that any remaining costs of the band be covered by the Thrivent Choice funds. Billie seconded. Motion carries. Entry doors: Talking about direction on the doors and how much to focus on security versus accessibility. The staff has been discussing our approach and considerations for safety. We have a safety committee that can work through options (including needs for Head Start) and they will bring

	recommendations back to the council including fob distribution/controls and eventual transition to new locks/keys (to eliminate access with old keys).
