Light of Christ to participate in 15th Annual Give to the Max Day on November 16th

Light of Christ is proud to participate in the 15th annual Give to the Max Day on Thursday, Nov. 16. Give to the Max is a

statewide grassroots giving event that raises tens of millions of dollars each year for more than 6,000 causes across Minnesota and beyond. Considered Minnesota's holiday for generosity, donors have given more than \$290 million to more than 10,000 organizations since the inaugural Give to the Max Day in 2009.

To participate in Give to the Max, donors may visit GiveMN.org and search for the causes they care about most by name, keyword, ZIP code or related keywords. Give to the Max's Early Giving period continues through Give to the Max Day on Nov. 16, with random drawings throughout for more than \$100,000 in prize grants for Minnesota organizations.

Additionally, each donation through GiveMN.org gualifies Light of Christ for additional prize grants, thanks to the continued generosity of the Bush Foundation. Through this year's campaign, GiveMN will award:

- \$500 Early Giving Golden Tickets daily through Nov. 15
- \$500 Golden Ticket prizes every 15 minutes on Nov. 16
- \$1,000 Hourly Golden Ticket prizes hourly on Nov. 16
- \$6,000 Power Hours, shared among the top three organizations based on amount raised between 10:00–10:59 a.m. and 10:00–10:59 p.m. on Nov. 16

Food Distribution—Monday, November 13th

What should I do? How do I live out my faith? What difference am I to make? All great questions. **We wonder**, how do I make my mark? How can I translate my beliefs into meaningful action? What is to really matter for me?

People have been asking these questions for eons. The Bible speaks of those who were listening to Jesus teach: "And the crowds asked him, 'What then shall we do?' And he answered them, 'Whoever has two tunics is to share with him who has none, and whoever has food is to do likewise.'" Luke 3:10-11

One practical way we seek to "do likewise" here at Light of Christ is through our monthly food distribution to neighbors in need. Each second Monday there are two opportunities to serve. At 10:00 am at Our Father's Lutheran in Rockford, where we pack hundreds of boxes of various food items for distribution later in the day at our five partner churches. And then at 3:30 pm that same day here at Light of Christ where we then distribute almost 100 boxes to those who come. You don't need previous experience, and you are left with a sense with which you are making your mark, translating your faith into action, and doing what really matters.

Did you know the universal symbol for honoring a Veteran is holding your hand over your heart? When you see a member of the Military, honor them by holding your hand to your heart! Remember: November 11th is Veteran's Day. Contact a Veteran you know and say **"THANKS!!**"

Armistice Day commemorates the signing of the end of WWI (the war to end all wars) at 11:00 a.m., November 11, 1918 (name changed to Veteran's Day in 1954). The poppy was one of the only plants growing on the barren battlefields. On May 3, 1915, while looking at the grave of his close friend and former student, Canadian surgeon Lieutenant-Colonel John McCrae composed the poem, *In Flanders Fields*.



Verse 1 In Flanders fields the poppies blow Between the crosses, row on row, That mark our place; and in the sky The larks, still bravely singing, fly Scarce heard amid the guns below.

(The battlefield spanned southern Belgium and northwest France)
