

Thank you to our 2025 Belize team below for all you did to make our MISSION FROM GOD so successful. Our mission was March 1-8 in Bella Vista, Belize.

This team raised over \$4,000, received donations/purchased toothbrushes, toothpaste, floss, eyeglasses, glucose strips/ monitors, medications, school supplies, clothes, prizes for Bible store, large parachute, candy, slingbags, and VBS supplies.

We traveled to Belize with 18 checked bags (50 lbs. each) plus carry-ons to deliver all the donations we needed.

We were able to use the money we raised to serve a dinner to 160 members of Pastor Kebin's church, host Vacation Bible School for 220+ children, deliver food packages to 20 homes, furnish a mini-propane stove, water, hot food, and chairs to a home visit, build 4 picnic tables, 4 bunk beds, 1 corn hole game, steps for church, 2 bike racks, and a gaga pit.

Our team was welcomed into Pastor Kebin's home for meals, worshiped together, shared our God sightings, enjoyed learning about the main industry in Bella Vista banana farming, and snorkeled as a team on Caye Caulker.

We so appreciate all the donations we received from LOC/LOC Youth and others in our





















community. We also thank Pastor Kebin Rosa's family and the people of Bella Vista who welcomed us with open arms and loved us as brothers and sisters in Christ.



March Fifth Sunday Offering

In March our LOC Fifth Sunday offering will go to Second Harvest Heartland that provides food to the Delano Food Shelf and LOC's Nourishing Hope Food Distribution. Second Harvest Heartland is one of the largest, most efficient and most active hungerrelief organizations in the nation located in Brooklyn Park. As a food bank, they provide low cost or free food to food shelves, schools, community centers and other organizations in MN and western WI. Currently, they support over 1,115 organizations and more than 1,000 food shelves. Nearly 2/3 of the food they provide is fresh including meat, produce, bakery and dairy. Last year, they provided 128 million meals. For every \$1.00 donated, they can provide 3 meals to hungry neighbors. We are looking forward to providing food to as many Minnesotans as possible through our LOC Fifth Sunday donation. There is a link on our LOC website under the "Give" tab for donating. 


