



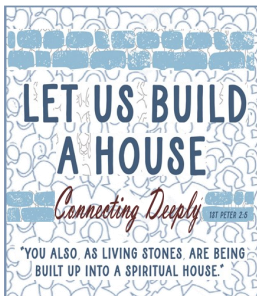

MEMBER OPPORTUNITIES



Committees are the heart and soul of Light of Christ. Lay leadership within committees allows for members to make their own mark in this community. Each committee functions differently, but all come together to give this congregation life, energy, and new goals.

Interested in serving on a committee? Contact the Nominating Committee (Mike Boyack: mkboyack@yahoo.com or Natasha Werner: natasha.werner@target.com) or the church office. Below is a brief summary of each LOC committee, which are typically two-year terms. More

information can be found on our website under [Serve/Committees](#):

- ⇒ **Church Council:** elected members serve a three-year term and are responsible for the general oversight of the congregation.
- ⇒ **Children & Family Ministry Team (CFM):** responsible for the education programs of children 3 years old through 6th grade.
- ⇒ **Community Life:** responsible for initiating the fellowship life of the congregation, including potlucks, picnics, and more.
- ⇒ **Endowment:** helps LOC members make legacy gifts through estate planning or with major gifts at any point that fits their financial life.
- ⇒ **Finance:** assists the treasurer and Church Council and oversees the church finances.
- ⇒ **Healing and Wholeness:** brings awareness, education, prayer, and support to those experiencing mental illness, loneliness, grief, or brokenness.
- ⇒ **Library:** organizes the collection and catalogs items into specific areas of interest in the church library.
- ⇒ **Mission/Evangelism:** responsible for evangelism and outreach to members and the community.
- ⇒ **Mutual Ministry:** responsible for affirming and strengthening the mission of the congregation and the ministry of the called staff.
- ⇒ **Personnel:** supports the Church Council and church committees in hiring staff and other HR activities.
- ⇒ **Property:** oversees the care and maintenance of the church property.
- ⇒ **Stewardship:** promotes the Christian discipline of stewardship through the use of members' time, talents, and finances God has entrusted to them. Works to educate the church on the ministries their gifts support, methods of giving, organizing annual stewardship campaign, and connecting fundraising activities to principles of stewardship.
- ⇒ **Technology Team:** supports the technology needs of LOC, reviewing equipment replacement schedule, and providing support to staff as needed.
- ⇒ **Worship & Music:** provides vision and oversight to the worship and music ministry, and assists the music director with general planning of worship, recruitment of worship assistants, and other special projects.
- ⇒ **Youth & Family Ministry Team (YFM):** visions, plans, and implements the ministries for youth and families in grades 7-12 and post-HS youth.
